Golf at Harbour Pointe

Cost: \$185

Opening in 1991, Harbour Pointe Golf Club was quickly selected Golf Digest's best new public golf course. Just five years later, it was rated second best golf facility in the Northwest, 1996, by the same publication. With two different courses to play, Harbour Pointe's luscious greens are lined with water and trees to make for a beautiful landscape. The views of Puget Sound and the Olympic Mountains top off the experience. Following breakfast, groups of four will begin their game in a modified shotgun start that will allow everyone to play simultaneously. A private lunch will be served following the tournament, catered by the Harbour Pointe Golf Club. Tour time: 6:15 am – 2:00 pm

Seattle Underground Tour

Cost: \$75

The Underground tour of Seattle begins with a seated introduction inside Doc Maynard's Public House, a restored 1890's saloon. Next, your group will walk outside through historic Pioneer Square to three different sections of Underground—about three blocks in all. Be prepared for the underground landscape to be moderately rugged: you'll encounter six flights of stairs, uneven terrain and spotty lighting. Dress for the weather—and leave your spike heel shoes at home! The tour ends at Rogue's Gallery, where you'll find portraits of Seattle's colorful characters and other displays depicting Seattle's past. Here you'll have a chance to purchase work by local artisans and mementos of your visit. Upon completion of the tour, your guests will dine at the House of Hong in the International District of Seattle. House of Hong is a Dim Sum restaurant which means "From the Heart" in Cantonese. House of Hong was chosen as the City's Best Chinese Food by AOL Cityguide and named Best Dim Sum restaurant in a local Best of Western Washington Tour time: 10:30 am – 1:30 pm

Cruise the Locks

Cost: \$100

Since 1963, locals and visitors alike have enjoyed the 2-1/2 hour guided Locks tour. The cruise connects the salt water of Puget Sound and the fresh water of Lake Union via the Hiram Chittenden Locks. Enjoy live narration of Seattle's history, while viewing the historic waterfront. View the spectacular city skyline one of the world's largest shipping terminals, the majestic Cascade and Olympic mountain ranges and the "Sleepless in Seattle" houseboat community. Tour time: 11:30 am – 2:15 pm

Snoqualmie Falls & DeLille Cellars Tour

Cost: \$125

One of the Northwest's most prized secrets, Snoqualmie Falls boasts Washington's reputation for being luscious and beautiful. At 270-feet tall, the waterfall is surrounded by a two-acre park, hiking trails, observation deck, café and gift shop. Your guests will be accompanied by a personal tour guide that will tell about the history of the area and share some of the interesting secrets Washington has to offer while they admire the beauty of the falls. Following the tour, your guests will enjoy wine tastings and lunch at the well known DeLille Cellars. A small winery located in Woodinville, Washington, DeLille Cellars was originally founded in 1992 by Greg Lill, Jay Soloff, Chris Upchurch and Charles Lill. Simply stated, DeLille Cellars' goal is to make the very best handcrafted, old-world style red and white wine made in the State of Washington. To date, the winery has won several awards and has become one of Woodinville's best boutique wineries. During the tasting, a DeLille wine connoisseur will walk guests through the different wines, and give a special presentation on the history of the winery, the wine making process, and the different types of wine.
